BEGGING FOR THE BEACH The first time Alex and Jessica Phillips took Teak to the beach, "he took off as soon as his paws hit the sand, rolling and digging like a maniac," Jessica says. Once he smells the ocean or sees the sand-which happens frequently at their Manhattan Beach home-the 1-year-old puppy relentlessly pulls his owners toward the shore.
